## Information about the Competition

Entry fee: If a nation sends a judge and/or a technical specialist: 30.- EUR per skater If a nation does not send a judge or specialist: 40.- EUR per skater

Number of skaters: Germany, Netherlands, and Switzerland:
4 ladies per category
4 men per category
4 pairs per category
All other nations:
3 ladies per category
3 men per category
3 pairs per category
Skaters who had won a medal on European or World Championship in free skating are not allowed to start in the same category.

Judges:
Each nation should send a judge and/or technical specialist.
There must be a minimum of 4 judges and 3 technical specialists.
Travel expenses are to be paid by each nation itself.
The organizer will provide lodgement in twin rooms (two bed rooms) from Thursday until the following morning after the competition. If a judge prefers to stay in a single room, the difference of the room rate must be paid by his federation or by himself.

Meals and drinks during the competition will be covered by the organizer.
If a nation brings no judge they must pay higher fees for each skater.
The nation should announce the name of the judge(s) and technical specialist(s) together with the entries.

Regulations: $\quad$ Rules of World Skate ATC apply to all free skating and pairs categories. Rules of World Skate Europe apply for all promotional pairs categories. The rules can be found on the corresponding web pages.
